Dr. Christian Garbe has been Managing Director of FiZ Frankfurter Innovationszentrum Biotechnologie GmbH since its founding in 2002. Subsequently, Dr. Christian Garbe began his professional career at Novartis in Basel, where he assessed potentials of biotechnology for product developments. After transitioning to DZ BANK AG in Frankfurt, he analyzed pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies there and successfully managed a biotech fund.

The focus of his work is in the development of international business models and innovative, data-driven technologies. In doing so, he consistently implements the megatrend of digitalization and the topic of industry 4.0, in which processes are digitized in a platform-based manner and used in practical applications.

To date, Dr. Garbe has authored over 80 biotechnology/pharmaceutical investment articles and reports, including the book “Chance Biotechnologie – Leitfaden für Investoren” issued by the FAZ publishing house.
